Separate sealed Bids for **ESMERALDA COUNTY EMERGENCY GENERATOR PROJECT PHASE TWO** will be received by the Board of Esmeralda County Commissioners, the **Owner**, at the office of the Esmeralda County Clerk, P.O. Box 547, if mailed by U.S. Mail, and to be delivered by Hand, UPS or Fed Ex to 233 Crook Street, Goldfield Nevada 89013 until **2:00 P.M.**, local time, on **October 26, 2021**. The Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud at a special Esmeralda County Commissioners meeting on **October 26, 2021 at 3:00 p.m.**, at the Esmeralda County Courthouse, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, located at 233 Crook Street, Goldfield Nevada 89013.

The Work consists of Procurement and Installation of Generators more particularly described in the contract document and all other requirements as required by Contract Documents. The Contract Documents may be examined at the following locations: Bidding Documents may be viewed on the Esmeralda County Website at [accessesmeralda.com](http://accessesmeralda.com) under County Offices – Public Works/Utilities or by calling the Esmeralda County Public Works Department at 775-485-3483 for an in-person appointment. Physical copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained at the office of the Esmeralda Public Works Department, located at 400 E. Elliott Ave., Goldfield, Nevada, 89013. At the request of prospective Bidders, the Contract Documents can be mailed for an additional fee to cover the cost of postage and handling (at cost) or sent electronically. Questions and requests for Contract Documents should be directed to Michael Anderson at the Esmeralda County Public Works Office (775) 485-3483.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed form (separate Bid package) to include Bid Form, Contractor Qualifications Statement, List of Subcontractors and List of Major Material Suppliers, also accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the base Bid amount. Successful Bidders will be required to furnish both a payment Bond and performance Bond in the full amount of the contract price.

The BIDDER understands the Contractor and any Sub Contractor must be registered on SAMS.Gov and provide the Duns and Cage Numbers. The Bid cannot be awarded until Contractors and Sub Contractors Duns and Cage Numbers have been provided. The Owner will not award the contract to a Bidder who, at the time of submitting a Bid, was not properly licensed under the provisions of Chapter 624 of NRS or if the Contract would exceed the limit of the Bidders license.

A Pre-Bid conference for the project will be held at 1:00 p.m. on October 14<sup>th</sup>. Attendance at the Pre-Bid conference is encouraged but not required. The Pre-Bid will begin at Booster Pump Station #1, located near mile marker 25-26 on U.S. 95 in Esmeralda County.

Esmeralda County is an equal opportunity provider and employer. Bidders are to base their Bids on the Project funding being provided in whole or in part by Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and Esmeralda County. The Bidder must take affirmative steps to assure that disadvantaged businesses are used when possible as sources of supplies, construction, and services. The goals for minority and female participation are 12% and 10%, respectively. Executive Order 11246, Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications, apply on this Project. Davis Bacon Wage Rates apply on this project.

The **Owner** reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including, without limitation, nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional Bids. Owner also reserves the right to waive all minor informalities not involving price, time, or changes in the work.
